An earthquake is one of the most terrifying natural phenomena. We generally think of the ground we stand on as solid and completely stable. An earthquake can shatter that idea instantly when we see the ground move and buildings fall down. We only hear about earthquakes in the news every now and again, but they are actually an everyday occurrence. In fact, our planet experiences more than three million earthquakes a year. However, the vast majority of these earthquakes are extremely weak, and some of the stronger quakes affect uninhabited places, where they go largely unnoticed. It is only big quakes in densely-populated areas that get our attention. Until quite recently, nobody was sure what caused earthquakes. There is still a certain amount of mystery surrounding them today, although we now have a much clearer understanding of the natural movements of rock beneath the surface of the earth that make the ground above shake. Enormous progress has been made over the past century. Seismologists have identified the forces that cause earthquakes, and developed technology that can tell us their size. They can even say where major earthquakes are likely to occur. Unfortunately, what they have not yet found is a way of predicting exactly when an earthquake is going to happen.
